JOB DESCRIPTION CONSIDERATIONS

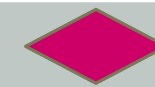
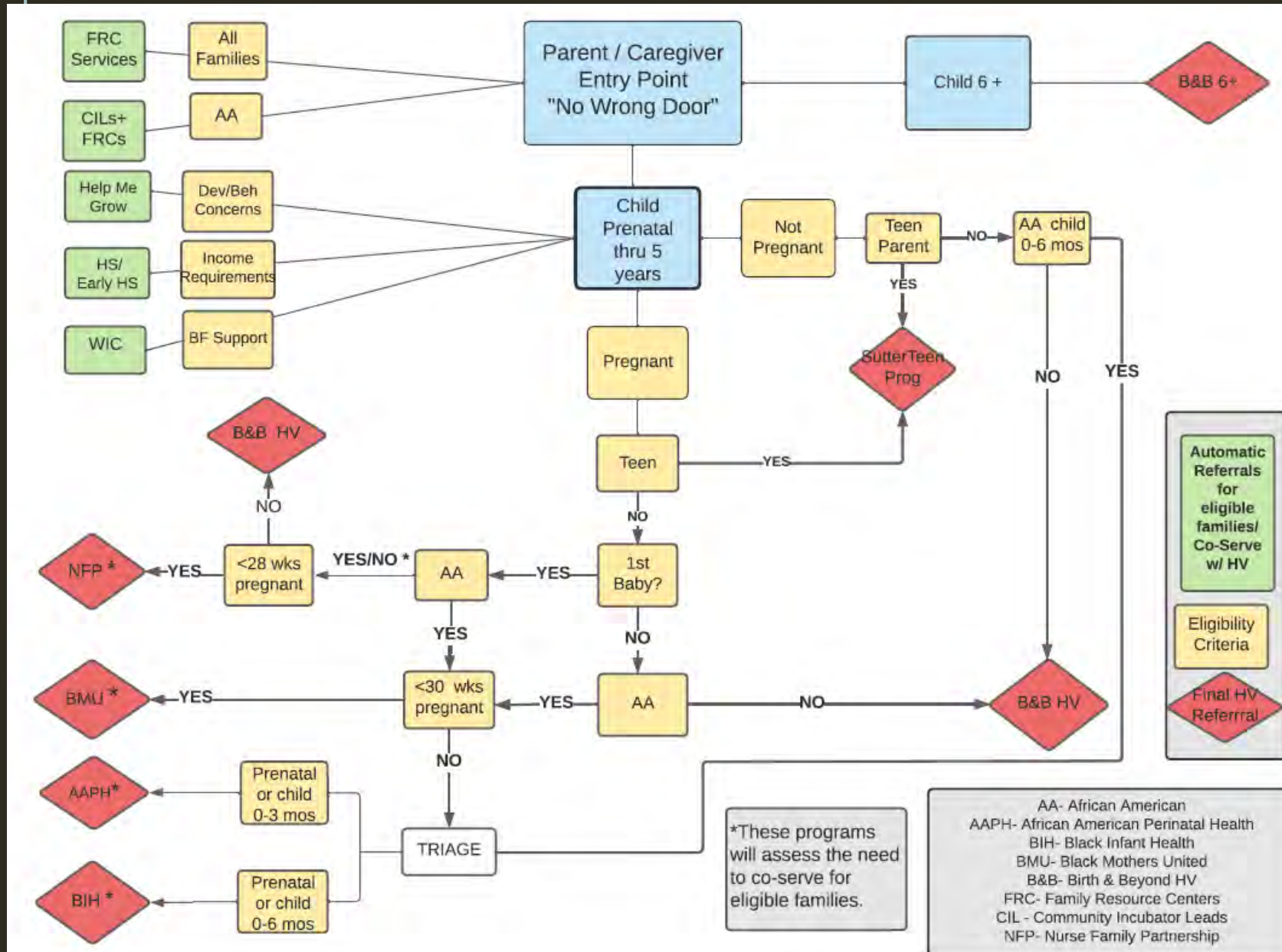
- Removal of “bilingual preferred” language
 - Stronger emphasis on experience over education
 - Hiring staff reflective of the community served
 - Inclusion of population and neighborhoods to be served
 - Inclusion of Fathers and LGBTQIA+ Families
 - Add Criteria Thresholds (i.e. “3 out of 5” desired skills)
 - Apply for grants for courses to supplement career development
 - Emphasis on Racial Equity Efforts to attract ideal candidates

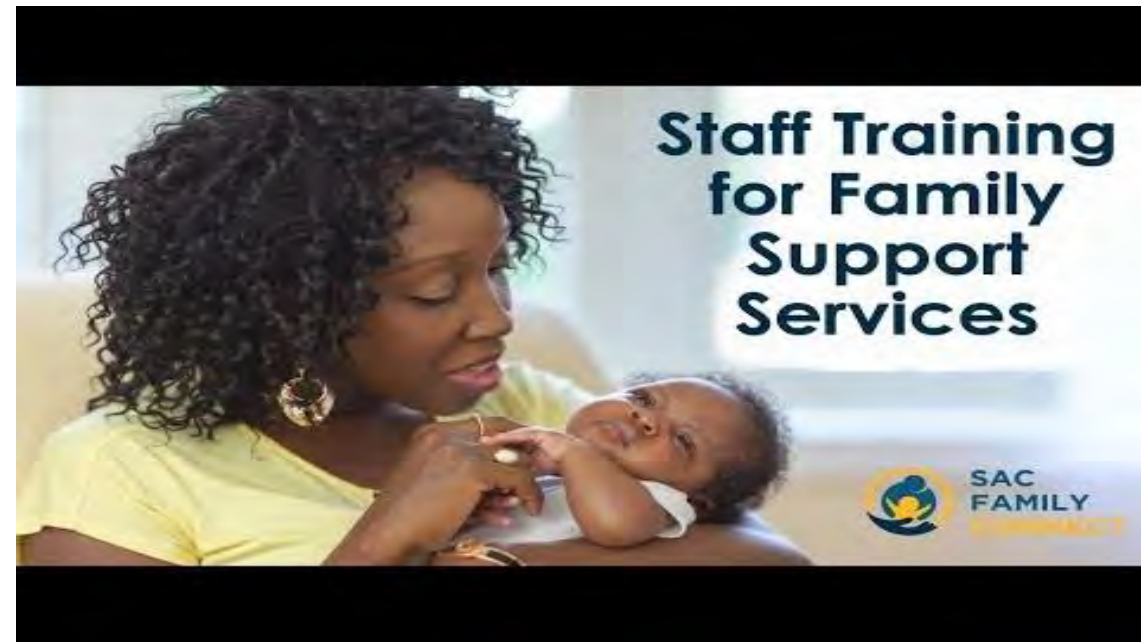
