Receive Update on Participatory Grantmaking (PGM) Process Stephanie McLemore Bray of Touchstone Leadership Group (TLG) gave a presentation on the Participatory Grant Making (PGM) process and the two upcoming community assemblies (one in person and one virtual). The meetings are designed to increase community engagement by developing a process to identify a deliberative panel responsible for managing the participatory grantmaking process.

TLG has also presented to the Commission's other committees with the goal of making sure that members have a fundamental understanding of PGM as a major systems change project. TLG will present the findings from the community assemblies at the December meeting.
